

HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS
BE SAFE BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER THE STORMS!

June – November is Hurricane Season so now is the time to prepare!

Know Your Zone – Indian Springs is in evacuation Zone B

It is critical to have a plan; especially if your condo is vacant during this time. Have a neighbor or someone close by check on your property before and after the storm. Be sure any items outside are brought in to avoid the wind carrying these through the air causing damage.

Communication is key! Keep in touch with neighbors, friends, and others who know where you are before/after the storm and what your plan is.

Document! It is key to take pictures before the storm of all of your assets covered by insurance before any storms and, should there be damage from the storm, take pictures after. This will assist not only with your insurance claims but FEMA and government assistance as well.

Have copies of key documents (insurance docs, tax docs, financial docs, etc) and keep in a separate location or with your storm supplies to take with you should you need to evacuate! Be sure you have cash on hand in case ATMs are down.

Get supplies ahead of time; water, batteries, etc. before the store rush begins.
